

## LADY PECKETT'S YARD

Begin at Lady Peckett's Yard and peek down the alley to find out about the first street! From here, turn and face the church opposite and head for Whip-Ma-Whop-Ma-Gate on the right.

## WHIP-MA-WHOP-MA-GATE

You'll find out more about York's smallest street in the window of No. 1-4 news. From here, turn back on yourself and head to the picturesque and historic Shambles, beginning on the other side of the church.

## SHAMBLES

Looking through the door of the blue-fronted Art Shop will tell you about the Shambles. After ambling up the cobbled street, turn left along the Little Shambles and walk through the market towards Parliament Square.

## JUBBERGATE

Above Roberto's gelato you'll find Jubbergate – take a look in their window to find out more about this quirky street!

## FINKLE STREET

Turn right up Parliament Street and keep walking to the square, where to the right of Browns you will find Finkle Street. Head up to VJ's Art Bar to find out more! Then, turn back on yourself and head left up Church Street.

## SWINEGATE

When you reach Game, turn down Swinegate. Walk down before turning right into Swinegate Court East and learn about its history in a window on the right! From Swinegate Court, head down the street to Coffee Yard.

## COFFEE YARD FORMERLY LANGTON LANE

Take a look through the window of Wildes Wine Bar and Bistro to discover more about Coffee Yard, and make sure to explore the pretty yard itself! From here, turn right up Grape Lane and right along Low Petergate.

As you walk down Low Petergate, keep an eye out for a snickleway on the right, next to Wildwood Italian restaurant. Congratulations, you've followed Alice all the way home and reached Mad Alice Lane! Read about her story in the window of Wildwood.
