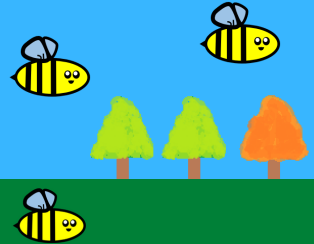




Keep Calm, Innovate and Bee Yourself!
