York's LNER Community Stadium will host 6 women's group games and both women's semi-finals. The city will also be the team base for New Zealand (men's) and Australia, New Zealand, France, Cook Islands (women's) teams.


As a celebration of York staging 8 Women's Rugby League World Cup matches, enjoy colouring in a montage of icons from the 8 countries taking part in the women's tournament.






















Women's fixtures at LNER Community Stadium, York
